

Stepping Stones Finger Tip Towel

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Size: 10.5" x 14.5"

Gauge: 9 stitches in 2 inches of stockinette

Yarn: Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn, @ 2.3 oz.

Notions: US 8 needles (or size to obtain gauge)

Size G crochet hook

Safety pin or similar style stitch marker

Abbreviations:

k = knit

p = purl

sts = stitches

Pattern:

Cast on 46 sts

Knit 4 rows

Section 1

Row 1: knit all

Row 2: knit 4, purl until 4 stitches remain, knit 4

Row 3: knit all

Row 4: knit 4, purl until 4 stitches remain, knit 4

Section 2

Row 5: k4, p3, *k2, p3* until 4 stitches remain, k4

Row 6: k4, k3, *p2, k3* until 4 stitches remain, k4

Row 7: k4, p3, *k2, p3* until 4 stitches remain, k4

Row 8: k4, k3, *p2, k3* until 4 stitches remain, k4

Section 3

Row 9: knit 4, purl until 4 stitches remain, knit 4

Row 10: knit all

Row 11: knit 4, purl until 4 stitches remain, knit 4

Row 12: knit all

Section 4

Rows 13-16: Repeat **Section 2**

Repeat **Sections 1-4** four more times (total of 5 repeats).

Repeat **Section 1**.

Knit 4, purl across until 4 stitches remain, k4. Repeat 3 more times. In last row, mark the middle of the towel between stitch 23 and 24 if a centered hanging loop is desired.

Bind off 23 sts purlwise; with a crochet hook chain for approximately 15 stitches from loop in 23rd stitch. Attach chain to 23rd stitch and then continue binding off. Weave in loose ends.
